

Formal Crawley Inter Faith Network (CIFN) began in June 2005. Prior to this an Interfaith group had been in existence in Crawley since the mid 1980s. The CIFN has a board of Trustees which consists of seven members who determine policy and co-ordinate the overall management of the Network. Trustees are drawn from all the major faiths in Crawley. The CIFN also has an Events Sub Committee which organises events and activities.

Crawley Borough Council (CBC) as part of its responsibility for Community Cohesion, has (through a service level agreement with CIFN), kindly provided funds for the employment of a Development Worker for a period of time. The Development Worker works closely with the Trustees and Events Sub Committee to further the work of the CIFN.

CIFN holds four 'Network Meetings' each year where developments of the past quarter are shared with the members and speakers are invited from different faith groups to give a presentation. Network meetings offer members the opportunity to share information and contribute ideas.

- To encourage an atmosphere of goodwill and peace between different faith communities.
- To promote and reflect on common beliefs as well as acknowledge differences and celebrate diversity.
- To help create understanding and respect between faith groups.

Our Objectives

1. To celebrate cultural diversity and promote unity
2. To work towards creating common ground
3. To provide a means for everyone to be involved in multi faith activities
4. To be an initial contact point whenever there is a need for consultation or assistance on multi faith issues
5. To arrange annual/regular activities which are religious, cultural and social gatherings, in order to foster understanding and learn from differences
6. To create dialogue to support bridge building amongst faith and secular communities in Crawley

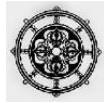

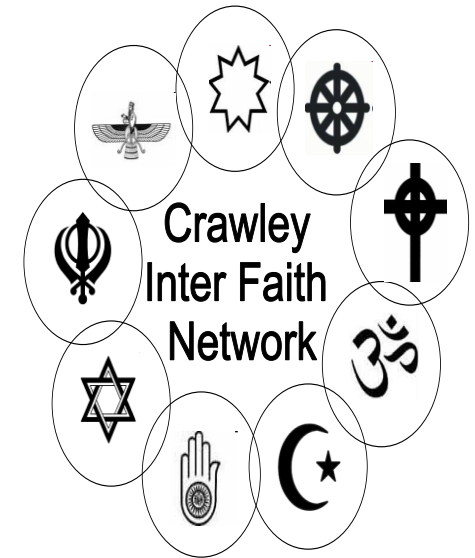
